The production and transportation of oil and gas via pipelines in the Caspian region are vital for Azerbaijan's economy and play a strategic role in the energy security of Europe and beyond. The EU's Eastern Partnership initiative aims to strengthen ties with Azerbaijan and other Caucasus countries, fostering economic development and political stability. Navigating these challenges and opportunities will determine Azerbaijan's future role and influence in the South Caucasus.

To address these issues, we welcome His Excellency Mr Vaqif Sadıqov, Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the Kingdom of Belgium and Head of Mission to the EU.
